- 5. A letter of interest that includes scientific goals (e.g. how you plan to use your Master's Degree), honors received, work experience, volunteer work, etc.**
- 6. An overview of the research planned and associated expenses for which the scholarship will be used. This overview should directly link the research to be supported by the 'Scudday' Scholarship to that of your thesis proposal.**
